Trade & Motor Dealer Stands - For the display of Vintage, Classic or Modern Cars and for strictly 'Motor Related' products or services only.

Catering Stands - All catering enquiries see separate 'Catering Pitch Booking Form'

Motor Club Stands - Car Clubs should pre-book stand size against anticipated demand. Members should book directly with the club. The actual number of cars being displayed, cost £10 per car, to be paid for by 1st June and stand size confirmed at that time. Price per car includes - all occupants of car, free Showguide (cover price £3), exhibitor card, site map and stand pass.

Note: All cars to be in place by 9am on show day and to remain static until 4pm

Pre-booked Private Car Eligibility - The event is open to any Pre-War cars and Post War Classic cars introduced prior to 1985, plus later Sports and Grand Touring cars and other cars of special interest, including Kit Cars, Specials, Replicas, American Cars, Custom Cars, Hot Rods and Modified Cars. *Note: Car club members to book directly their club if a 'club stand' has been booked.*

Autojumble Stalls - For any motor related products or spares only. No bric-a-brac, antiques or other items permitted.

Craft Stalls - There is a dedicated craft area, adjacent to the catering village, with stalls for quality products, including art, greetings cards, pottery, woodworking, jewellery, clothing (quality/retro) and specialist foods.

Membership - Provides for entry of that person to the Members marquee on the East Lawn with views over the main Showfields and lake, a buffet lunch, coffee/tea, cash wine bar and access to private restrooms. See separate leaflet or website for further details.

REGULATIONS

1. ORGANISATION

2. APPLICATIONS

Applications close on 15th June and must be completed on our printed form or via the website and accompanied by the required fee. Early entry is strongly recommended; very occasionally late applications may be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any applications without reason. Stands must only be occupied by the applicant and must not be sub-let or re-allocated to a third party. Sherborne Classic & Supercars Ltd and Sherborne Castle Estates are not responsible for any loss or damage to stand or private vehicle exhibitor's property whilst on site.

3. ELECTRICITY

There is very limited electrical power on site. Exhibitors are welcome to bring quiet running generators if required.

4. ADMISSIONS

All applications include admission to the Show and Castle grounds only, not to Sherborne Castle. All applicants will receive a free copy of the Showguide, which provides discounted entrance to the Castle.

5. CLUB STANDS JUDGING

Once again Motor Club Stands will be judged and cash awards made, the criteria maybe be found on our website. Clubs are encouraged to create attractive displays of members cars, to everyone's overall enjoyment.

6. ASSEMBLY, SET-UP AND BREAKDOWN

There are two castles in Sherborne; this event is held at Sherborne New Castle. For Sat Navs use postcode DT9 5NR.

Stand/Stall Set-up -Friday & Saturday 10am to 7pm, Sunday -7am to 9am.

PLEASE NOTE: All stand/stalls must be fully set-up by 9am on show day and all stands must remain static until 4pm. (Public open hours are 9.30am to 4pm)

Exhibitor parking is free and located at the East end of Showfield B.

Breakdown may commence from 4pm on show day and must be completed by 12.00 noon on the following Monday.

Pre-booked Private Car Assembly is on the Exclusive 'Showfield A' from 7 to 9am on show day, a site map will be sent with final instructions.

PLEASE NOTE: All cars to be in place by 9am on show day and remain static until 4pm. (Public open hours are 9.30am to 4pm) Separate display areas will be provided for Pre-War Cars, Supercars, American, Hot Rod, Custom & Modified Cars, Replicas, Specials & Kit Cars (subject to sufficient entries in any section). The organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry should the vehicle be deemed unsuitable or inappropriate for this event. Cars must not display 'For Sale' notices as there is an on-site Classic & Supercars auction on the day.

7. SECURITY

A security service will be provided on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights.

8. CAMPING

There will be no camping facilities or specific areas provided on the show site.

9. CANCELLATIONS

The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or amend the event if, in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, it is deemed necessary due to adverse weather conditions, or other reasons beyond the Organisers control. If an Exhibitor cancels a Stand booking, the fee paid, less a £10.00 administration charge, will only be refunded if the cancellation is notified in writing by the 15th June. Cancellation of private car bookings will not be refunded, the money will be donated to the benefitting charities.

10. INSURANCE

The Organiser has arranged Public Liability Insurance to the sum of £20 million. Stand Exhibitors should ensure they have adequate Public Liability Insurance cover to safeguard themselves in the event of an accident and any subsequent insurance claim. All Private Vehicles must be in a condition suitable for display and are to be insured.

11. FINAL INSTRUCTIONS AND PASSES

Final instructions and passes will be posted to entrants at least ten days prior to the event. Coloured hanging passes must be prominently displayed at the front of all vehicles for access to the site.

Exhibitors should follow on site signs to the correct stand number and avenue as indicated on their coloured hanging passes and shown on their site map.

DECLARATION

You are required by 'Sherborne Classic & Supercars Ltd' to read the following Declaration in full and duly acknowledge on the booking form:

'In consideration of the acceptance of the application and of my being permitted to take part in this show, I declare that any exhibits and/or products and/or vehicles brought on to the show site, whether forming part of a stand or not, will be in a safe condition. I further accept full responsibility for my own actions and those of any personnel appointed by me to assist on my stand, or who are exhibiting on my stand or passengers in my vehicle.
